Full-time enrollment for undergraduate students is 12 credit hours or more in regular A-F option or P/F option (5 credits for each summer term). Audit hours are not used to establish minimum full-time enrollments. Full-time enrollment for graduate students is 9 credit hours or more in regular A-F option, P/F option, or equivalent credit (5 credits for each summer term). Neither the payment of full fees nor compliance with maximums established as a condition of employment or appointment is basis for deviation from this definition.
