

# Virginia Tech Credits Required for the Awarding of a Degree

## Policy Memorandum No. 183

The University Council on recommendation of the Commission on Undergraduate Studies and Policies, unanimously approved a resolution concerning Virginia Tech credits required for the awarding of a degree.

Following is the text of the resolution as adopted by University Council.

**WHEREAS**, the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools states that all schools receiving accreditation must require that all degree recipients have earned at least one-fourth of their degree credit at the degree granting institution, and

**WHEREAS**, Virginia Tech does not now have in place, any explicit requirement stipulating that a minimum of one-fourth of the credit required for completion of a degree must be earned at Virginia Tech,

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that all students earning degrees from Virginia Tech must have earned a minimum of one-fourth of the credit required for their respective degrees from this institution, effective for students completing their undergraduate degree requirements Spring 1998.
